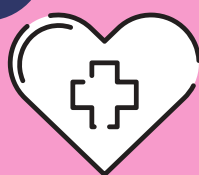

We will work closely with doctors, nurses and other healthcare teams to make sure your care is right for you.

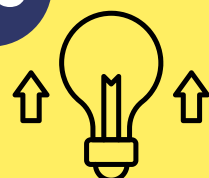
