What we would like you to know

- Access to a number of key destinations would be changed by the proposals for routes C3, 27 and 328. These include Chelsea and Westminster Hospital, St Mary's Hospital, Harley Street, Camden Market, Kilburn High Street, High Street Kensington, Paddington, Marylebone, and Clapham Junction
- Although we propose to change other bus routes to keep key journey links, some customers may need to change buses to continue making their journey in future
- Some customers would also be able to access new bus links which are not currently available
- Routes 27 and 328 would form part of a core bus network on which a high frequency service (a minimum 12-minute scheduled wait time between buses) would be provided on all days of the week from early in the morning to late at night
- Providing these high frequency routes would help limit the length of time that most customers have to wait at bus stops – helping to mitigate the impact of occasions where there is a need to change between bus routes in the future
- Our proposals would also result in a lower frequency of service for a small number of routes. Here, some customers may also have to wait longer at stops
- All our buses are low floor and 95 per cent of bus stops are accessible. This will also help to minimise difficulty for customers alighting and changing between buses in future
- The Hopper fare provides the ability to make a second journey within 60 minutes of boarding the first bus. Most journeys that may require interchange would be able to take advantage of the Hopper fare

How these proposals may change your current journey

- Customers would be able to make journeys as now, using a different service. The frequency of the services would not change.
- Customers would still be able to make the same journey, although the number of the bus they use would be different

Alternative travel options under this proposal:

- We propose to replace all journey links currently provided by route C3 by re-routing route 27.

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Customers who use route 27 should note the following

How these proposals may change your current journey

- A rerouting of the 27 would create new direct bus links between Paddington and the Earls Court/South Fulham areas with faster journey times and no need to change buses
- Some customers would need to change buses to complete their current journey if the proposals were to go ahead. This would involve changing between route 27 and route 328, which may result in longer journey times than at present

Interchange options under this proposal:

- For journeys towards Hammersmith, same stop bus interchange would be available at nine stops between Pembridge Villas and Phillimore Gardens. To assist customers waiting to board, all stops have shelters and seating
- For journeys towards Camden same stop interchange would be available at eight stops between Phillimore Gardens and Pembridge Villas. To assist customers waiting to board, all but one of these stops have shelters and seating

	via West Hampstead, Kilburn, Notting Hill, Kensington, Earls Court	This would replace bus links between Notting Hill and Kensington Church Street with Hammersmith currently provided by route 27 if it were to be re-routed as proposed	We want to ensure that we match capacity on our bus services with demand for them and that we have the right number of buses serving destinations where people want to go

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Customers who use route 328 should note the following

How these proposals may change your current journey

- Re-routing the 328 would create new direct bus links between the Westbourne Park/Kilburn Park areas to High Street Kensington, Olympia, and Hammersmith. Customers would have faster journey times without needing to change buses
- Some customers would need to change buses to complete journeys which they can currently make using one bus and may experience longer journey times as a result. This would involve changing between the 328 and 27 buses to complete journeys

Interchange options under this proposal:

- For journeys toward Chelsea same stop interchange would be available at 10 stops between Pembridge Villas and Phillimore Gardens. To assist customers waiting to board, all of these stops have shelters and seating.
- For journeys toward Golders Green same stop interchange would be available at 10 stops between Phillimore Gardens and Pembridge Villas. To assist customers waiting to board, all of these stops have shelters and seating
