# Pay to Moor:

# STUDLAND WATERSPORTS PATROLS

Local SBMP member Studland Watersports have 2 vessels that patrol the Voluntary No Anchor Zone daily throughout the boating season.

On hand to help share information on how boaters can pay to moor, the team can also check which vessels have a seasonal pass, have paid for their mooring or can take a direct payment on the water with their 'tap to moor' system.

Be prepared for the new boating season - download and sign up for the NEW mooring payment system via <u>Sippi</u>. It makes payment quick and simple.

#### STEP 1

Download the Sippi App (in advance is best!) and create an account with your payment details - you do this only once!

### STEP 2

No pre-booking, if you find an available ecomooring - it's yours to moor to!

#### STEP 3

Moor your vessel, when you are settled...

#### STEP 4

Check the location code on the pick up line tag or buoy - select this location code in your app or input it

# STEP 5

Make your payment which is £7.50 for up to 4 hours, £15 for up to 24 hours on the same buoy or choose to purchase a seasonal pass for £150

## STEP 6

RELAX - you have just supported marine conservation at Studland Bay
