Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Notice is given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 19, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 49, 51, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby proposes to make the following order:-

The effect of the Order will be to introduce new or to extend or amend existing waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road (in this part of the notice DYL means waiting to be prohibited at all times by double yellow lines at the times prescribed below).

Roads in St Margaret's-At-Cliffe in the District of Dover

BAY HILL – DYL - On the southwest side place a Bus Stop Clearway from its junction with Lighthouse Road for a distance of 19 metres in a south easterly direction. SEA STREET – DYL – (1) On southwest side from a point 38 metres southeast of its junction with Reach Road extend the existing DYL by 33 metres in a south easterly direction. its junction with High Street to a point 18 metres northeast of the boundary of 116/117 High Street. (2) On southwest side from a point 281 metres southwest of its junction with Reach Road extend the existing DYL by 18 metres in a north westerly direction. (3) On the southwest side from a point 5 metres from its junction with Lighthouse Road extend the existing DYL by 14 metres in a north westerly direction. (4) On the northeast side from a point 10 metres northwest of its junction with The Droveway extend the existing DYL by 5 metres in a north westerly direction. THE DROVEWAY - DYL - On the northwest side from a point 8 metres northeast of its junction with Sea Street extend the existing DYL by 5 meters in a north easterly direction.

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 19, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 49, 51, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act,hereby propose to make the following Order:-

Revocations, Modifications and Amendments

In this Order the expression "Order of 2005" means "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005". The Order of 2005 shall have effect as though:

In the Schedule to the Order of 2005

SCHEDULE 1.00 NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

Roads in St Margaret's-At-Cliffe in the District of Dover

The following entry to be inserted to the First Schedule of the Order of 2005 in place of the existing entry:-

HIGH STREET

- (1) On the northeastern side
- (a) from a point 10 metres northwest and 10 metres southeast of its junction Millfield;
- (b) from its junction with Kingsdown Road to its junction with Sea Street;
- (1) On the southwestern side
- (a) from its junction with Townsend Farm Road for a distance of 28 metres in a south easterly direction;
- (b) from a point 58 metres southeast of its junction with Sea Street.

The following entry to be inserted to the First Schedule of the Order of 2005 in place of the existing entry:-

SEA STREET

- (1) On the southwestern side
- (a) from its junction with High Street for a distance of 72 metres in a southeasterly direction;
- (b) from a point 263 metres southeast of the junction with Reach Road for a distance of 48 metres in a south easterly direction;

- (c) from its junction with Lighthouse Road for a distance of 18 metres in a north westerly direction.
- (2) On the northeastern side
- (a) from a point 10 metres northwest of its junction with The Droveway to its junction with Graville Road;
- (3) from its junction with High Street Preston Hill to a point 18 metres southeast of its junction with Chaple Lane.

The following entry to be inserted to the First Schedule of the Order of 2005 in place of the existing entry:-

THE DROVEWAY

- (1) On the northwest side
- (a) from the junction with Sea Street for a distance of 13 metres in a northeasterly direction;
- (b) from a point 7 metres northeast and 7 metres southwest of its junction with Downside;
- (c) from a point 7 metres northeast and 7 metres southwest of its junction with Kenilworth Close;
- (2) On the southeastern side form the junction with Sea Street for a distance of 121 metres in a northeasterly direction.

This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No.106) Order 2023" ('this Order') and shall come into operation on the day of 2023.
