

# Elia Mews and Widford House Communal external space concept design

Following the resident consultations which took place in February and March 2024, the Council have developed proposals to make improvements to the communal outdoor spaces of Elia Mews and Widford House.

A summary of the proposed improvements is provided below. Further details of the proposals to the Widford House Community Garden, the multi-use games area (MUGA) and children's play area are provided on the following pages.

#### A Widford House Community Garden

The proposals include re-design of the community garden as follows:

- Removal of part of the existing brick wall adjacent to the ballcourt and replacement with railings to open up views across the site.
- A new fence boundary adjacent to Widford House, increasing the size of the garden to incorporate areas of pavement where fly tipping has historically been an issue.
- Dedicated growing area with accessible raised beds and retention of the no-dig growing area.
- Tool storage shed, compost bins and a watering point.
- Low maintenance sensory garden with seating.
- Support for the gardening group from Green Growing Solutions.

#### B Multi-use games area (MUGA)

The proposals include providing a new multi-use games area to replace the existing worn-out facility.

Vegetation to the boundary of the court has been thinned to remove hidden spaces where anti-social behaviour has been reported.

## C Children's play area

Proposals include upgrading the play area to provide a greater diversity of play equipment and seating.

### D Access

Access improvements include a new footpath link between the multi-use games area and playground, and an additional access to the east of the playground to Elia Mews.


### E Biodiversity enhancements


The proposals include:


- New tree planting.










Existing community garden boundary wall and MUGA

#### **Community Garden Boundary**

- Boundary fencing (1.3m high)
- Existing brick retaining wall
- New boundary fence (1.8m high) to allow views from the community garden to the sports court and children's play area.

#### **Access and circulation**


- 4 Growing area entrance gate

- 1/1 Entrance signage and notice board




# Multi-use games area (MUGA)
